**New Business:**

Dr. Kathleen Ludicello (HLC & Dual Enrollment)

- Dual Enrollment Credits – There will be a townhall on the 20<sup>th</sup>. This townhall will discuss the requirements/waver of Dual Enrollment.
- Vote has been taken by the HLC. The decision has not been released. Should come later this week. Dr. L will deliver the result to Dr. Eric L.
- Waiver
  - Bachelor's degree in discipline
  - AZ teaching certificate in discipline
  - Three years in discipline
  - From Spring 2024 – September 2025 (new HLC faculty requirements)
- Dual 12-week course
  - HS wants training
  - Courses
    - Eng 101/107
    - Eng 102/108
    - Psy 101
    - Language Clep
    - ARH 141/142
    - Humanities
    - Lab Science
  - Ellen Riek is creating training
  - Working with Scott Estes to see if AWC and high school Canvas can communicate
  - Strained relationship: HS wants only one contact, but that may not work well with AWC personnel and faculty.
  - May be stipends to help create courses similar to winter courses.
  - High school wants more professional development and stipends

- Concerns:
  - What constitutes teaching experience?
  - EDU 250 No longer required
  - Unqualified teachers taking students from community college.
  - Students getting cheaper product instead of from qualified faculty.
  - Who is pushing?
    - HS wants more dual enrollment
    - AWC wants to help create equity
  - Less Qualified/Larger class sizes
  - Why can't the student take class from AWC faculty?
  - Will HS administration factor in passing grades. How do we know student has truly learned/mastered objectives/goals?
  - This squeezes adjuncts out. Community Colleges would play a smaller role in higher ed.
  - HS teachers are less qualified
  - Prodigious difference between gaining expertise in the history & theory of the pedagogy of writing and rhetoric studying it for years, taking exams, then teaching.
  - What about quality of experience
  - What I do in my class cannot be contained in a tidy module. It came through years of study and training.
  - Share Syllabus????
- Dr. Kathleen will meet with Dr. Eric at a later date
- Encourage your fellow faculty to attend town hall.

#### Instructional Excellence Coordinator

- Copy of IEC please ask faculty to review and comment by 11/20/23.
- 16-week training; more holistic study and pedagogy support.
