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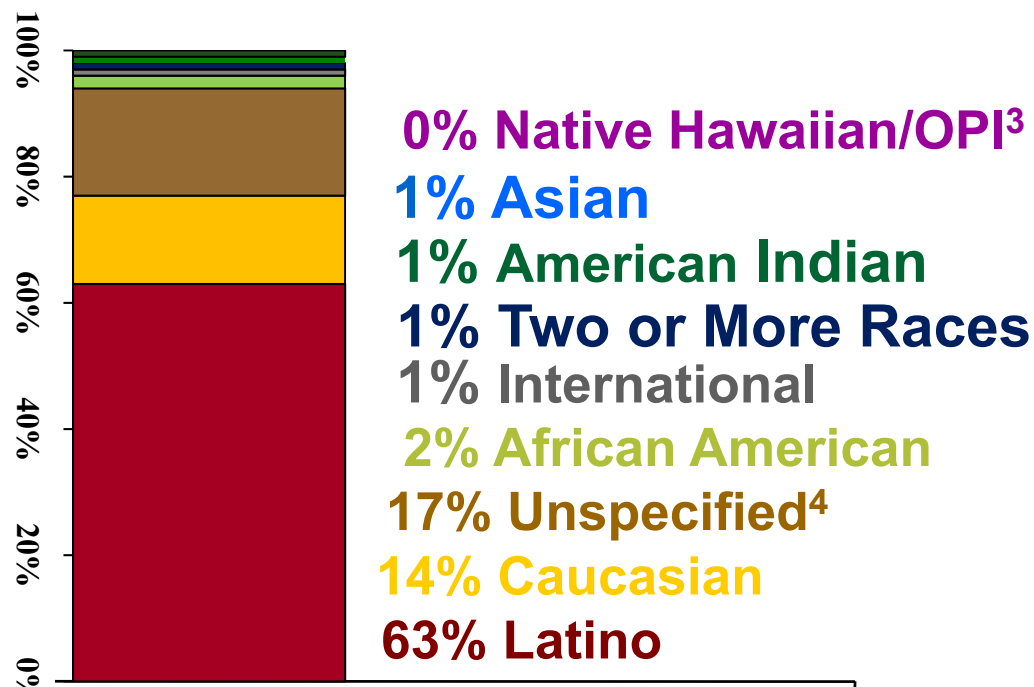

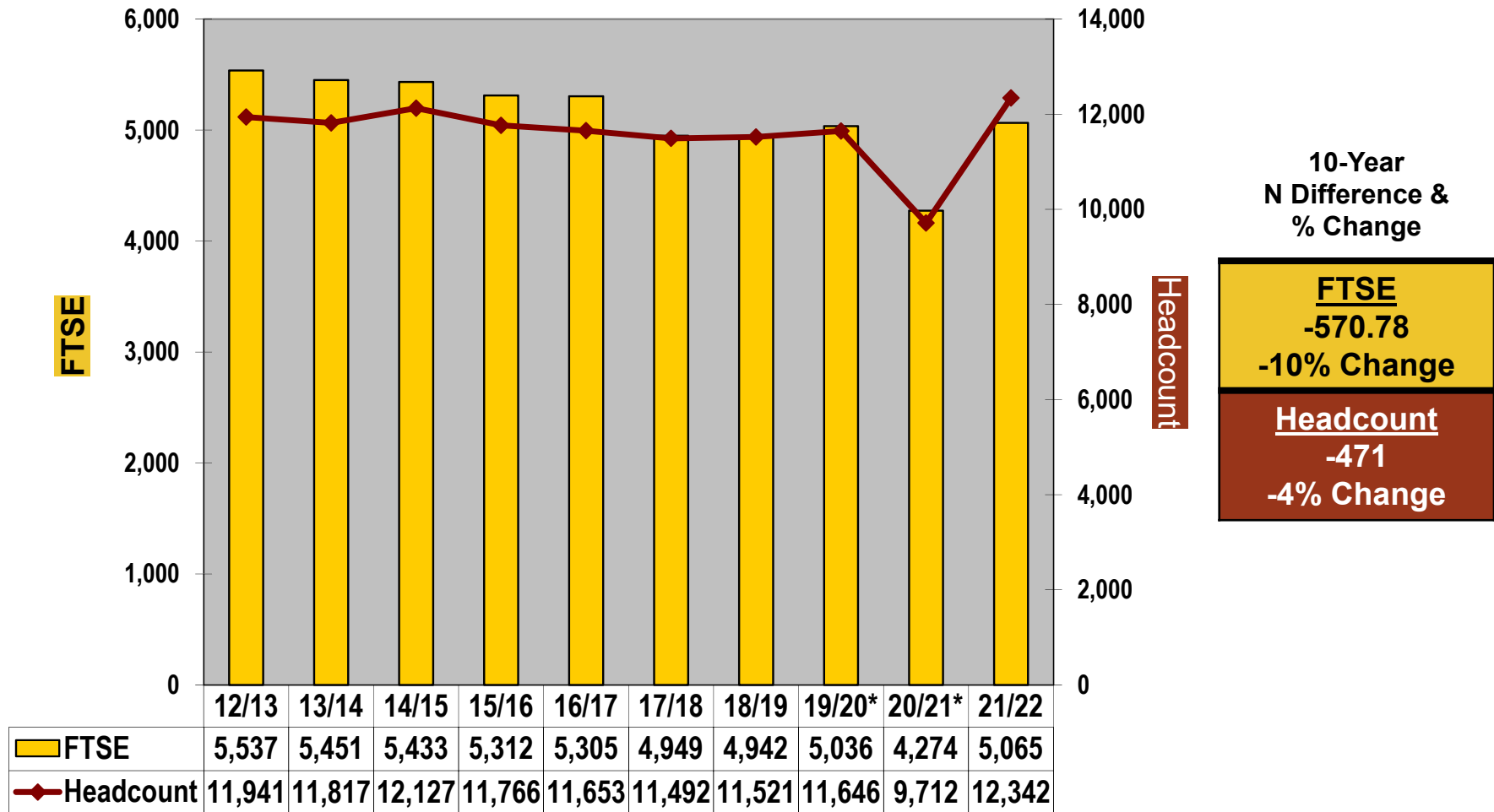

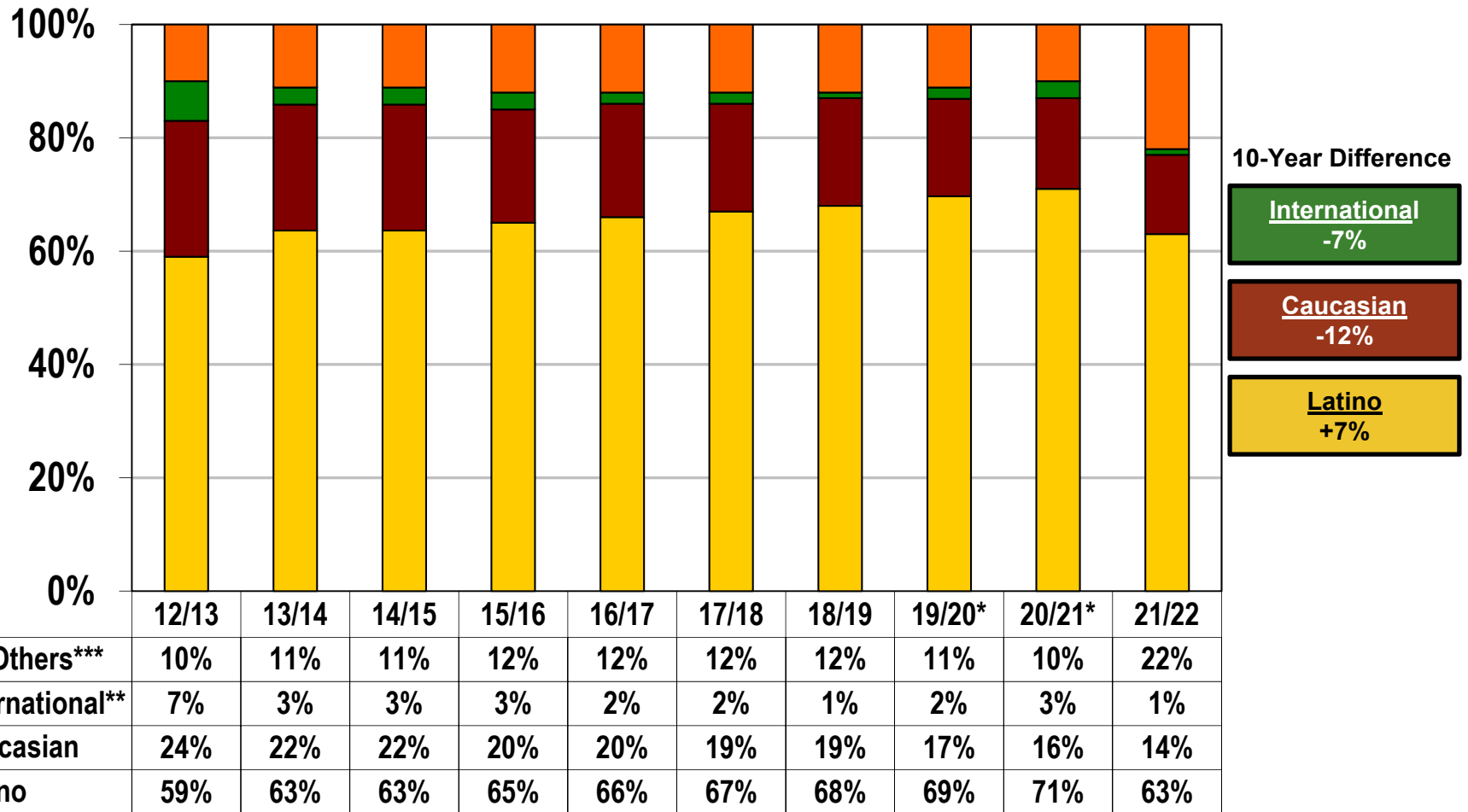
# 10-Year Trend of Total Student Headcount & FTSE

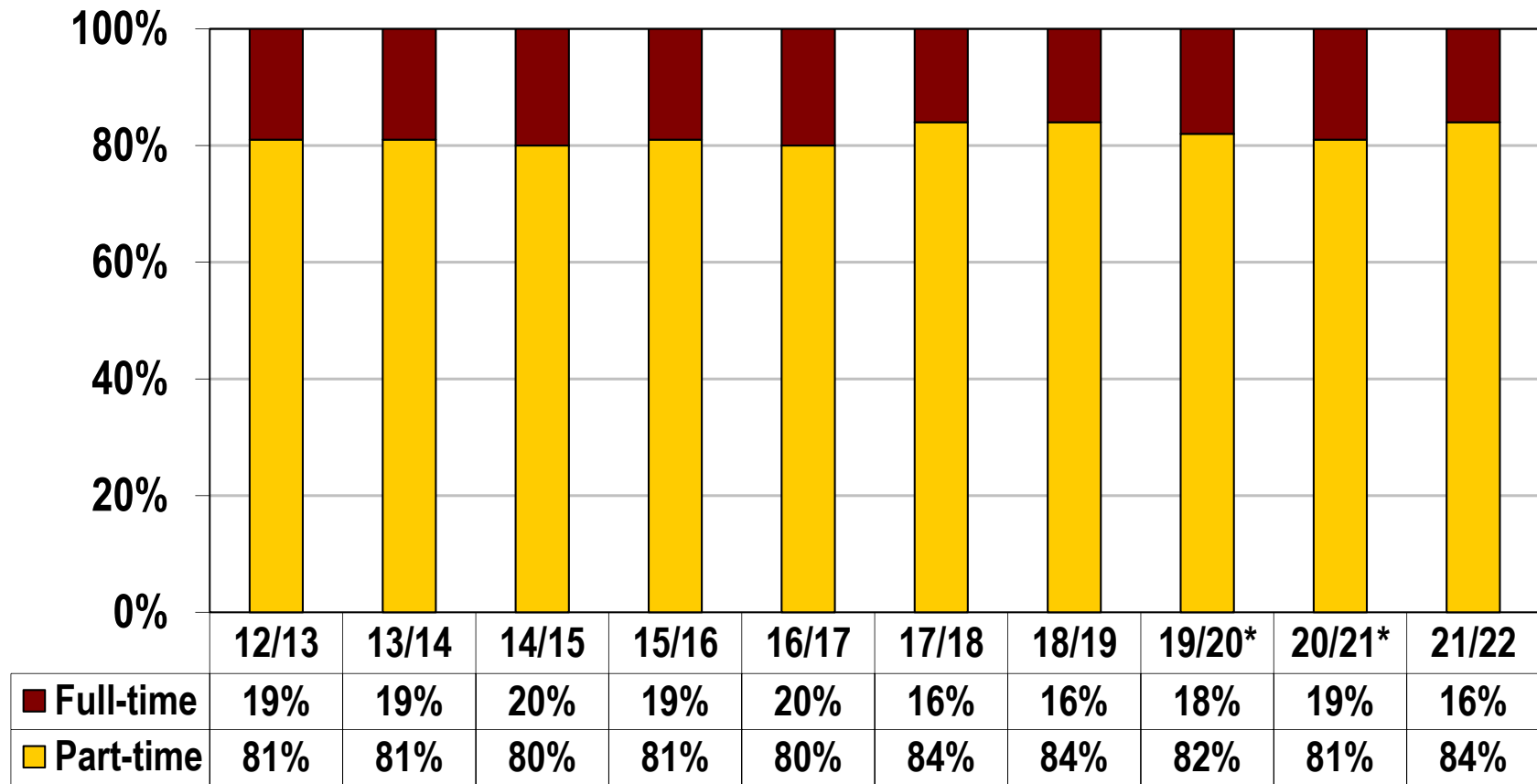

*Despite the predominance of traditional college-age students, most students attend part-time.*

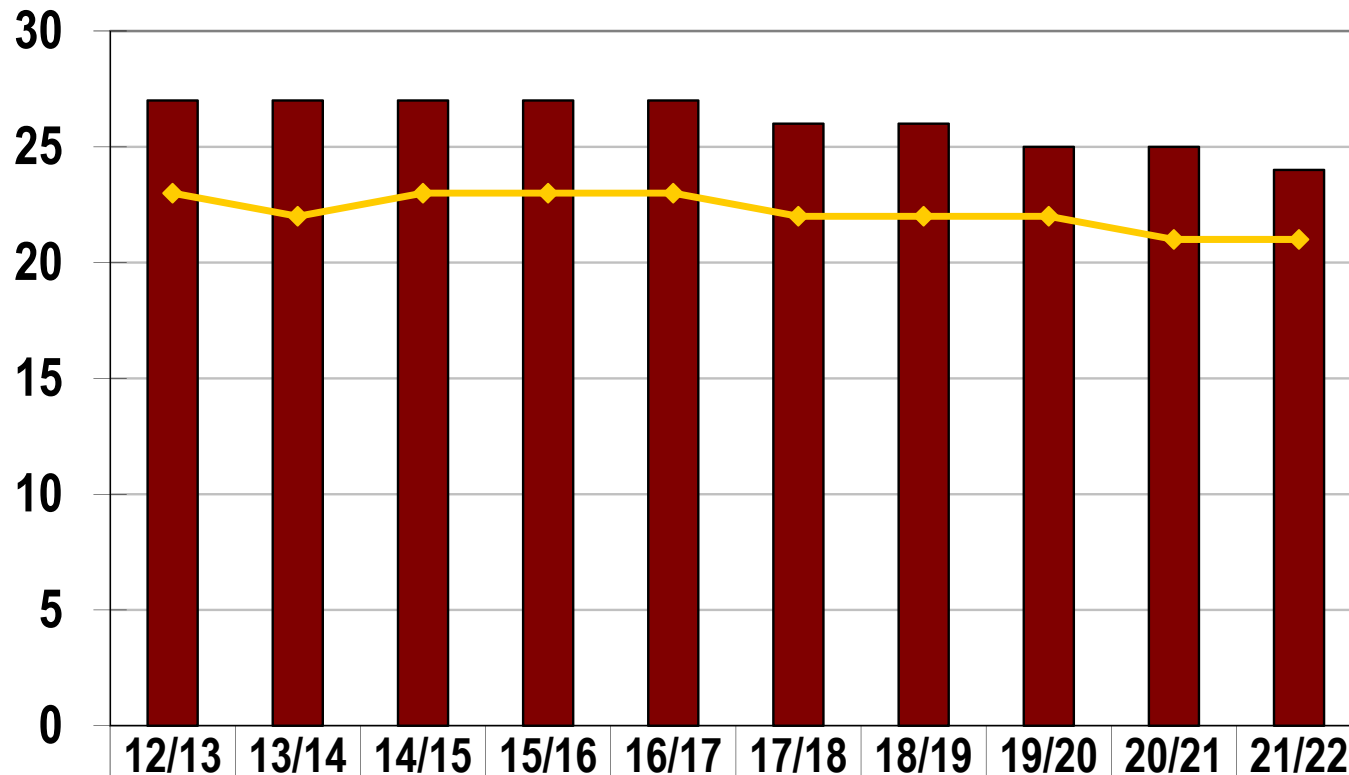

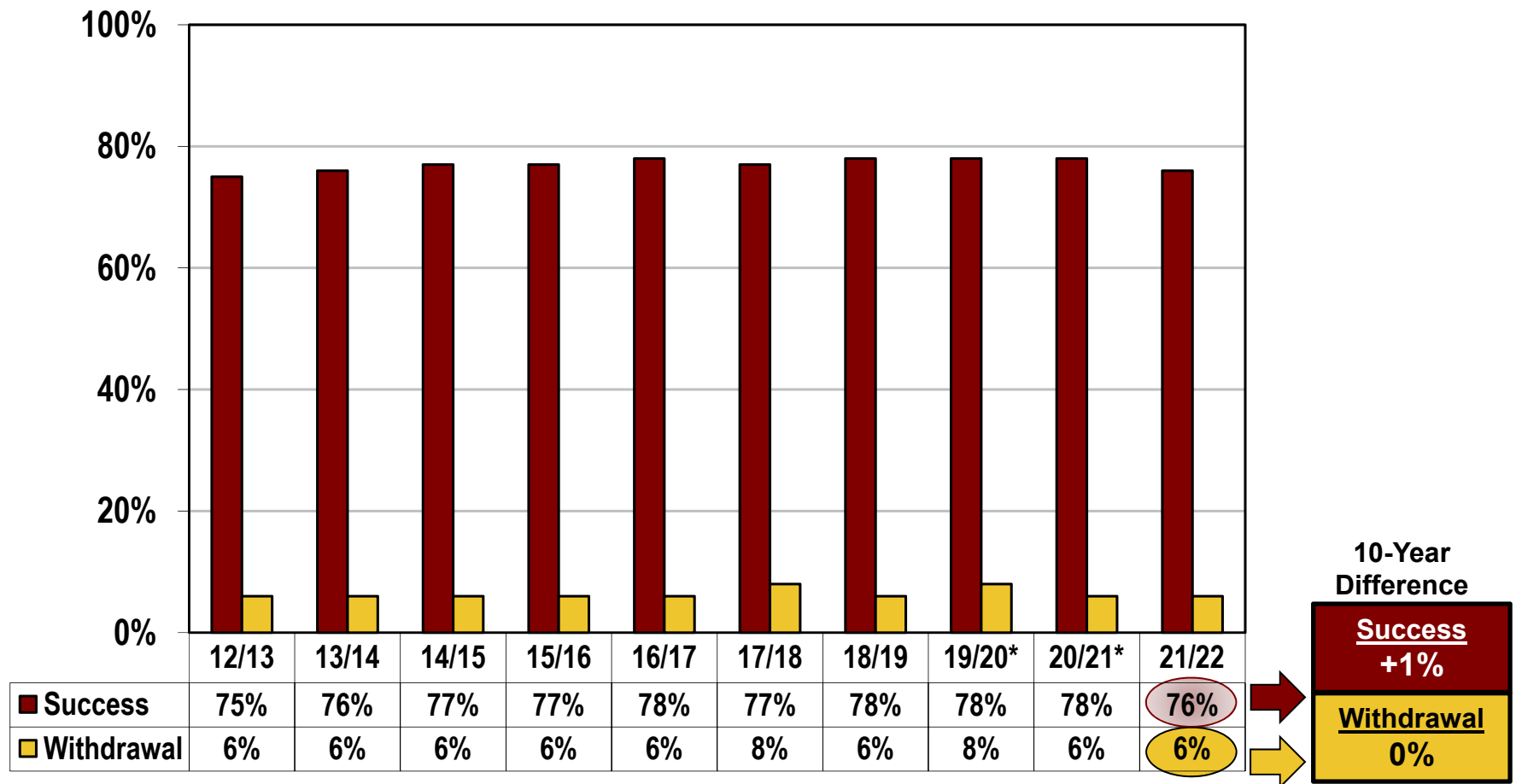

# 10-Year Trend of Overall Academic Success & Withdrawal Rates

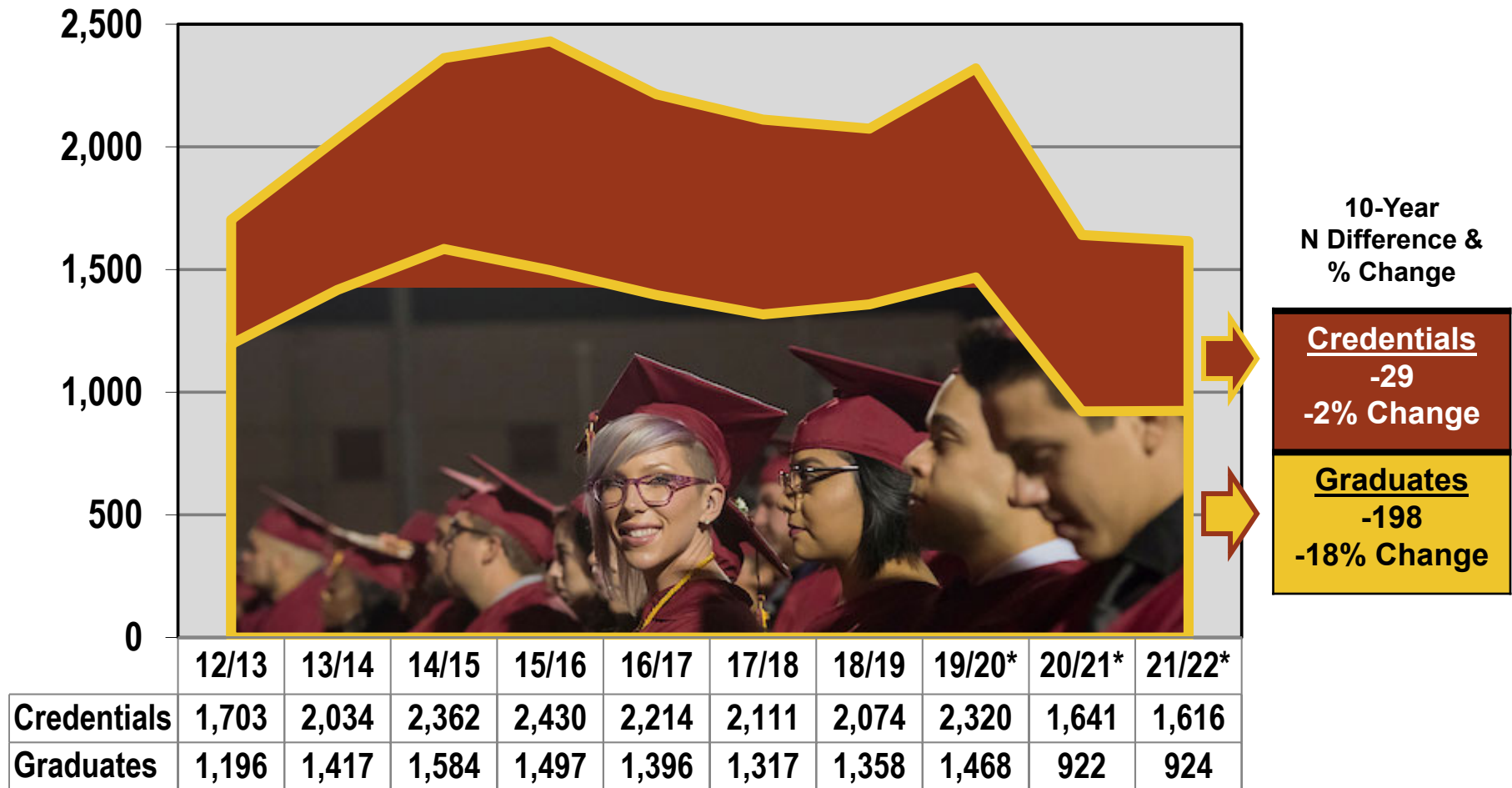

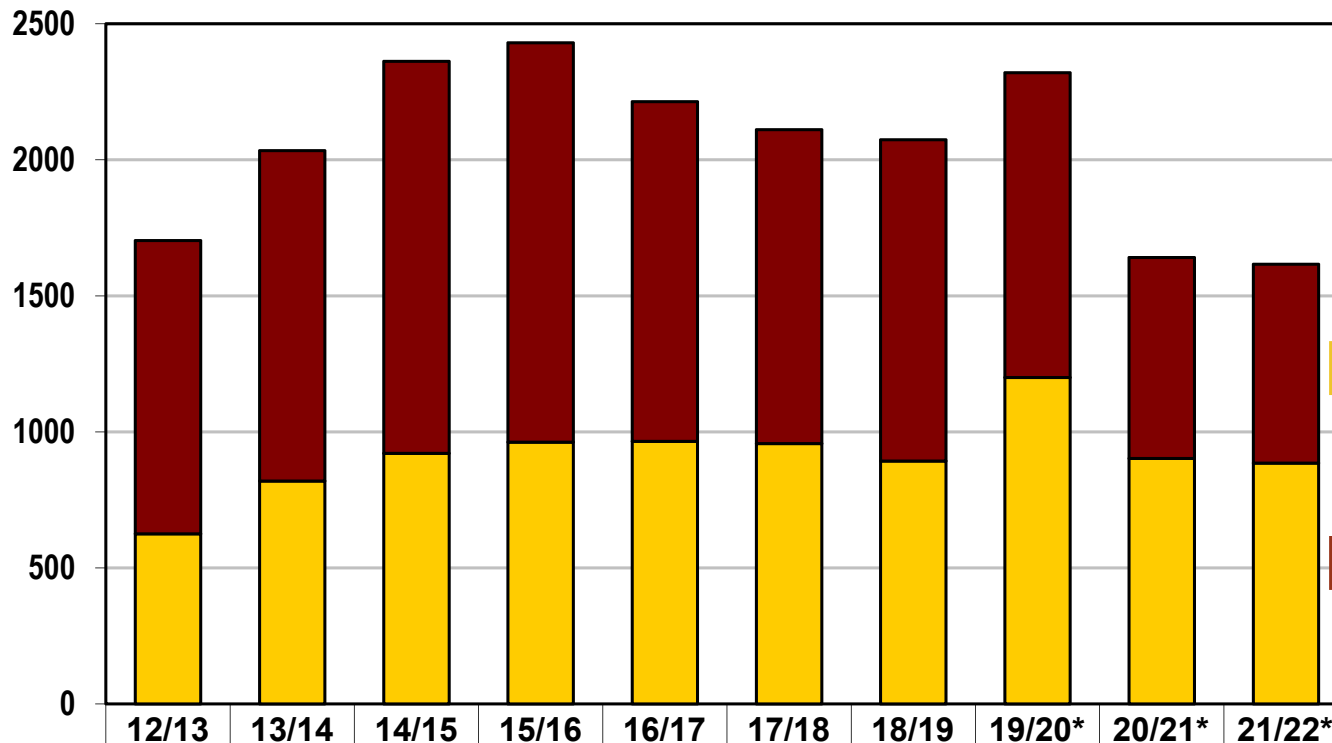

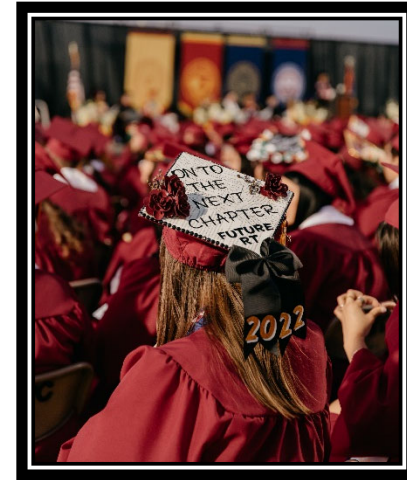
