This fast-track training will provide individuals with the basic skills required of an entry level employee in the carpentry industry. The training curriculum is aligned with the National Center for Construction Education Research standardized national skills standards for the construction trades. Topics covered include: introduction to reading, interpretation, and visualization of blueprints in construction; floor foundations and interior/exterior framing, including various types and methods of building foundations and framing systems; necessary skills and experience to understand the various types of wood framing systems.
